GARDENING STEVE

Hi to all you gardeners. As I write things are slowly warming up but we are at least three weeks behind regarding what should be flowering in the garden. The trees are now beginning to leaf. We are in June and this is halfway through the year and the summer solstice is soon upon us. June is

when you should have all your bedding plants in all your beds and containers etc. Continue to deadhead roses and other plants regularly to give colour throughout the summer. By this time of the year the lawns should be cut at least once a week and preferably twice a week if possible. The less grass taken off at each cut the healthier the grass will remain. Mow in a different direction each time because if you mow in the same direction on several occasions the grass begins to grow in that direction and the mower blades, especially those on a cylinder mower will not cut it. Also, keep the lawn edges cut the same time as the grass is cut. It makes all the difference to the appearance of the garden. Hoe or hand pull annual weeds while they are small as this will save a lot of work during the rest of the summer. Anyway, hope you have a great time in your gardens and enjoy the summer weather. See you next month.

THE LANSDOWNE HALL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Trustees and the Management Committee of the Lansdowne Hall held their AGMs on the 25th April, during which the Management Committee presented its annual report. The highlight of the report was the announcement that the Hall had obtained Hallmark 3 accreditation, having previously been awarded Hallmark 1 and 2. This award recognises the high standard under which the Hall is administered and maintained for the benefit of our community and makes it only one of a handful of Halls in the County who have achieved this highest of awards.

The Hall continues to be well used and now has 22 Regular User Groups (one up on last year) although there was a slight drop in casual use. Many minor building and maintenance works have been carried out to improve the appearance and functionality of the Hall and it is hoped (grants permitting) to completely refurbish the kitchen later in the year. There has also been set in place a forward looking costed maintenance programme. On the financial front a small surplus was made before depreciation and due to the prudence of our Treasurer expenditure was kept under control.

The Hall will again be participating in this year Village Fete and make its facilities available to all those who attend. One of our members, Paula

Edwards, has played a major role in securing funding for a defibrillator to be attached to the Hall and whilst the Hall is not contributing financially to this project it is happy to be a player in ensuring that vital life-saving equipment is available.

The meeting re-elected Nicholas Roberts as Treasurer and Alan Rosekilly as Secretary with Richard French volunteering to act as Chairman for four months only following David Sandberg's decision to stand down from this post and this allows us breathing space to make a permanent appointment. David was thanked for his dedicated commitment during his chairmanship. The report thanked Victoria Stimson who had completed ten years of dedicated service as the Hall's Administrator. Our cleaner and caretaker were also thanked for their hard work. Thanks were also expressed to the Trustees and Users for their support in helping make the Lansdowne Hall one of the most thriving Halls in the County. The Trustees re-elected Jim Cook as Chairman and Alan Rosekilly and Richard Aylen as Secretary and Treasurer respectively.

DERRY HILL DEFIBRILLATOR

We are about to start the refurbishment of the phone box prior to the installation of the defibrillator. The defibrillator for the outside of the Village Hall will also be installed soon. Watch this space for details of opening ceremonies!



When we have these two up and running with enough funds to cover on-going expenses we will be thinking about raising more funds for a defibrillator for Studley

We are continuing to raise funds - so all suggestions for raising funds will be welcome.

Later in the year we will be arranging public awareness training sessions in the Village Hall carried out by professional trainers with life-sized dummies to remind people how to carry out CPR and to become familiar with defibrillators, to give people more confidence.

You don't need to be an expert in the use of defibrillators because those with public access are designed to be used by any untrained person - you have to dial 999 and the Ambulance Service will give you full instructions over the phone as you go along. Also the machine itself will give audible and onscreen instructions.



....for Derry Hill, June 1953.....

The officers of the Church elected at the Annual Meeting are as follows:- Vicar's Warden, Lord Lansdowne; People's Warden, Mr. W.G. Phillips; Secretary, Miss Jean Daniels; Treasurer, Mr. E. Holman; Members elected to the Parochial Church Council, Lady Lansdowne, Mrs. W.G. Phillips, Mrs. Tapper, Miss R.M.M. Binns, Messrs. H.C. Tapper, M. Phillips, M. Rex, H. Cole, G. Harrison, W. Short, E. Daniels, F. Angell, C. Luxton. In addition our representatives on the Ruridecanal Conference, Lady Walter Harvey, Mrs. G. Haddrell,

and Miss F. Mountjoy, are ex-officio members of the P.C.C.

The Bishop's Pilgrimage to the Avebury Deanery was an outstanding success. It was, of course, something which could only happen about twice in our lifetime. His Lordship was met at the Parish Boundary at Hazeland

Mill at 7.30 a.m. by your Vicar, Churchwardens and Treasurer. He was the Celebrant at 8.0 a.m. at the Parish Church, and after breakfast at Bowood, started on his walk accompanied by the Vicar. He visited 48 homes and talked to 105 people, besides visiting Messrs. Beints' Sawmills and the School. At the latter place he took prayers, talked to teachers and pupils, and inspected the work of the enthusiastic children. Many of them will never forget the experience. Unfortunately we were about half an hour behind schedule, and so many people were disappointed in not seeing and talking with the Bishop. His only rest was about ten minutes, after lunch at Rumsey House.

There is to be a great Service of Thanksgiving on the site of the cathedral at Old Sarum on the evening of July 1st. It is requested that ten people should represent this parish. Perhaps you would care to come. Several parishes are combining to arrange transportation, so if you plan to come with us, please let me know immediately.

The meeting of the Parish Council on Monday 13th May 2013 primarily dealt with the recent election . The Parish is split into West Ward (Derry Hill, Studley & Chilvester), Middle Ward (Stockley), East Ward (Calston, Blacklands & Lower Compton), Sandy Lane and Pewsham. A total of 15 councillors make up the Parish Council of which 5 represent Derry Hill and Studley, namely

Richard Aylen, Colin Bell, Richard French, Ed Jones, & Matt Maddocks

At the meeting Ed Jones (Derry Hill) was re-elected Chair and Barry Miller(Lower Compton) Vice- Chair. Brian Vines was co-opted onto West Ward to represent Chilvester. There were two councillors for the single seat at Sandy Lane and this was won by a secret ballot of councillors by Barry Satchell.

Other items covered were updates on various works in progress, approval of the balance sheet and approval of Audited Accounts.

The Parish of Calne Without includes Calstone, Lower Compton, Ratford, Derry Hill, Pewsham, Studley, Sandy Lane, Stockley and Mile Elm.

The Parish Council is setting up a Steering Group to initiate the revision of the Parish Plan and look into the possibility of creating a Neighbourhood Plan.

A Parish Plan sets out where the Parish is at the moment in terms of Transport, Economy, Environment, Recreation, Tourism, Crime and Housing and what its residents aspire to happen in the future.

A Neighbourhood Plan sets out what the Parish would like to see in any development taking place, for example:

- choose where new homes, shops and offices should be built
- have a say on what those new buildings should look like

Such a Plan would have to conform to Wiltshire Council's Plan.





REVEREND ANN WRITES

As I write I am beginning to look forward to the summer and the many events that will be taking place. There are three weddings in June, and I do love weddings – they are wonderful times of joy and hope. There is the Dolls House Festival with a ‘profusion’ of flowers – an exciting event for all ages – teas and a barbecue as well as a cheese and wine evening over that weekend (28-30 June). Then there is the fete in July – which is action packed and sounds like even more fun than usual with the decorated wheelbarrows stirring up those creative brains amongst us! Teddy bears too will be coming down zip wires from the church tower, nervously watched by their owners.

To start it all off though we begin with the Diamond Jubilee; didn’t we do that last year, I hear you say! Well, yes, but..... Last year was the Diamond Jubilee of the ascension of Her Majesty to the throne and this year it is the Diamond Jubilee of the Coronation of the Queen. 


