## SLOW WORMS

**Anguis fragilis** are neither worms nor snakes but legless lizards: they lay eggs and have eyelids, blink and also have small ears! They are totally harmless and a good indication of the health of the land. But like much else are under threat.



The skin of slow worms is smooth with scales that do not overlap one another. They are able to shed their tails to escape predators, but it does not reach its original length. They shed their skins in patches.

Adult slow worms grow to be about 50 cm long and are known for their longevity living about 30 years in the wild and up to 54 years in captivity. The female often has a stripe along the spine and dark sides, while the male may have blue spots dorsally. Juveniles of both sexes are gold with dark brown bellies and sides with a dark stripe along the spine.

Emerging from hibernation in March, the slow-worm may be seen to bask in the early morning and evening sun, as the animals come into condition for breeding, which occurs in May. The young take 4 - 5 months to develop, being produced in late August to early September. The Slow-worm is ovoviviparous; ie the young are born in an egg membrane that breaks soon after birth. Between 3 and 26 young are produced, the average is 8. New born slow-worms are very small: 70 and 100 mm at birth. Males and Females show a marked difference in colour when fully grown. Females very often have a dark vertebral (back) stripe, the flanks are flecked or striped with dark brown or black, the ventral surface is nearly always uniform black. Adult males are more uniform in colour dorsally and on the flanks, the belly is usually mottled black or dark grey, they also have proportionally larger heads. Occasionally males have very distinct blue spots. The upper parts of the body vary from light or dark brown, grey, bronze or brick red. Being 'semi-fossorial' (burrowing/spending most of its time hidden under objects) they are common in gardens and can be encouraged to enter and help remove pest insects by placing black plastic or a piece of tin on the ground. One of the biggest causes of mortality in slow worms in suburban areas is the domestic cat, against which it has no defence.

Please remember it is a criminal offence to kill or injure any of the UK's native reptiles. So be kind if you see one, and make a small habitat in your garden they can call a home.

## ACTION FRAUD

There is a phishing email currently in circulation that claims to be from the City of London Police. The departments that it claims to represent include the '**Fraud Intelligence Unit**' and the '**National Fraud Intelligence Bureau**'. The email is titled '**compensation fund**' and has a letter attachment that claims to be offering financial compensation to victims of fraud. The letter uses the City of London Police logo.



The letter states that in order for compensation to be arranged, the receiver of the email should reply disclosing personal information. It states that HSBC and the South African Reserve Bank have been chosen to handle the compensation claims. All of these claims are false. The email and letter are fraudulent and should not be replied to.

## Protect Yourself

- Opening attachments or clicking links contained within emails from unknown sources could result in your device being infected with malware or a virus.
- The City of London Police and the National Fraud Intelligence Bureau will never email you asking for you to disclose personal information.

If you believe you have become a victim of this fraudulent email get your device checked by a professional and make a report to Action Fraud, the UK's national fraud and cybercrime reporting centre:



## THANKS EVERYBODY!

As you may know, on 11 August I felt that I wasn't getting enough attention so I had an episode of Ventricular Tachycardia (a very fast heart rate). More often than not, this is fatal but, despite me losing consciousness, Ann managed to bring me round in time for the paramedics' arrival and I was rushed off to the Great Western Hospital.

The Swindon cardiologists decided that Oxford was the best place for me so I had a very interesting journey in the back of another ambulance, with flashing lights and "Wooh-waahs". Don't ever be tempted to tailgate an ambulance that is parting the traffic. They have three DVD cameras on the rear of the ambulance and two on the front! An Audi driver on the A34 will have received a visit from the police.

What caused my heart to go bonkers is not known. Oxford did establish that my coronary arteries are fine so it was most likely an "electrical fault". Whatever the cause, it stressed the heart-muscle significantly. When tested on arrival in Oxford, my heart was functioning at less than 20%!

I now have a CRT-D (which is a state of the art "Cardiac Resynchronisation Therapy and Defibrillator" device) implanted instead of the old pacemaker and am recovering slowly. I feel very tired!

Thanks so much for all the cards and good wishes. They mean so much.




## BOOK CLUB REVIEW

## REVEREND ANN WRITES

The warmth of the sun is still managing to break through the cold nip in the air. The clear, fresh mornings are just the kind of mornings I like. No doubt the sun's warmth will have faded to more wintery levels by the end of October, but it is good to enjoy it for as long as it is around!

Harvest Festival has taken place and the smell in church was fantastic when I entered the church first thing today. We have so much to be grateful for living in this country. Many of us are here because this is where our parents lived – an accident of birth for us.

That is why Harvest is so special – it is a time to recognise God's goodness and say 'thank you'. On the altar in church there is a card from the children who came to the service – it thanks God for being the source of all goodness. I feel sure he will be as delighted to receive a card as any of us!

All the proceeds from the Harvest Auction of fresh produce will go with the preserved goods to Doorway in Chippenham. We hope and pray that our small efforts will give others, less fortunate than ourselves, hope in humanity.

The church life moves on at the beginning of October to what is called the Kingdom Season. It is the last season of the church year and therefore focus is on the end times. Not so much as to whether or not we will qualify for heaven but to focus on whether we are living our lives according to God's plan. If our intention is to be part of showing God's love to others, then we can discern what it is that God wants us to do for him. We are all linked together and each is dependent upon others. There are so many ways we can contribute to God's plan in both small and big ways. A good way is to think before we act. I read this today, when looking at a harvest website:

### A 'Chain' Story

- Knotgrass used to be a common farmland weed.
- Weed killers sprayed on cereal fields have made the knotgrass disappear.
- A leaf beetle called ***Gastrophysa polygoni*** only ate knotgrass.
- ***G polygoni*** disappeared when the knotgrass was destroyed.
- Partridge chicks used to eat a great many ***G polygoni*** leaf beetles.
- As ***G polygoni*** disappeared the number of partridges went down.
- So the destruction of a weed indirectly affected the bird populations on our farmland

Trying to work out what it is that God wants us to do will mean knowing what you are good at and how God wants you to use that gift. This is “**discerning vocation**”. Some are called to ministry – it doesn’t have to be ordained, it can be as a Lay Pastoral Assistant, Children’s Worker, Lay Reader and yet others are called to nursing and teaching in secular employment. To do well at anything I suggest one needs to have a natural instinct for it, a special talent recognised.
