May we examine our responses and pay attention to the questions which come to mind, and perhaps begin to explore where we think God is in our current situation.

I will continue to send emails to help us to travel together. If there are folk you know who cannot receive email, perhaps you might print something off for them, or give them a call to share something of the journey.
