

Isaiah 40:12-17,27-end

¹² Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand

and marked off the heavens with a span, enclosed the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance?

- ¹³ Who has directed the spirit of the Lord, or as his counsellor has instructed him?
- Whom did he consult for his enlightenment, and who taught him the path of justice?
 Who taught him knowledge, and showed him the way of understanding?

¹⁵ Even the nations are like a drop from a bucket, and are accounted as dust on the scales;

see, he takes up the isles like fine dust.

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some

doubted. And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'

Holy God, faithful and unchanging: enlarge our minds with the knowledge of your truth, and draw us more deeply into the mystery of your love, that we may truly worship you, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

Trinity Reflections

Daniel Migliore, in his book "Faith Seeking Understanding" states: "The doctrine of the Trinity redescribes God in the light of the event of Jesus Christ and the outpouring of God's transforming Spirit." It's a way of helping us to see that God's love for the world in Christ is now at work by the power of the Spirit.

<u>That's</u> what all this 'stuff' is about. All this tortuous grappling with words and terms and models is mind-stretching and fascinating – and there is so much more we can explore. But today, in these times, may we focus on this God of love who wants to share God's life and love in communion, and may we learn to live in loving, peaceful community with all our sisters and brothers; and with the whole of creation.

The last verse of the beautiful hymn from St Patrick's Breastplate or Lorica:

"I bind unto myself today
the strong Name of the Trinity,
by invocation of the same,
the Three in One, and One in Three.
Of whom all nature hath creation,
eternal Father, Spirit, Word:
praise to the Lord of my salvation,
salvation is of Christ the Lord."
