Please accept our grateful thanks to all, across the Marden Vale benefice, who donated to Calne Foodbank so generously through the harvest festival collections.

We have been encouraged at the support received from the community again this year.

It has been a year of change and we have been fortunate to find permanent premises more suited to achieving our aims.

To date this year, we have supported over 200 households in the SN11 area, issuing a total of over 1800 food parcels. This is **an increase of 27% on 2022**.
