This Maundy Thursday (28<sup>th</sup> March) at 7pm St Mary's is hosting a slightly different event to mark this really important moment in the church year, and anyone in the benefice is welcome to join in. We will be having a meal together - not a Seder meal as such, but simply lamb casseroles (with veggie alternatives) and puddings at tables at the back of church. The meal will be interspersed with the different stages of a special service, including foot or hand washing, and holy communion at the tables. When the meal has ended we will go to the other end of church for the traditional altar stripping, and as much vigil as you would like to stay for.
